

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Quilting Country Lanes

Tuesdays, January 29 and February 12, 19 & 26, 2013

M.B. Ainley Community Center, Corning

This 56" x 76" quilt is a twist of the original Country Lanes quilt pattern published by the Mountain Mist Batting Company in the 1930's. Expanded nine-patch pieced blocks alternate with large print or floral blocks.

Background—Fabric that reads as a solid	2 ½ yards
Chain One—Solid or very small print	½ yard
Chain Two and Binding—Solid or very small print	1 yard
Large scale print or floral	2/3 yard

If you wish to make your quilt larger after class you will need to double the fabric requirements for the background, chain one and chain two, and change the large scale print or floral amount to 2 yards.

Supplies to Bring to Class:

Sewing machine with foot pedal, cords, and needles (A ¼" presser foot is helpful).

Rotary cutter

Rulers (We will have a few rulers and mats that you can use.)

6" x 24" ruler

12 ½" square ruler

Pins
