What is Leadership Randolph County?

Leadership Randolph County is a nine-month program (September – May) designed to help participants become effective leaders and to facilitate increased involvement in the Randolph County community. Class participants develop an understanding of critical issues facing Randolph County, gain knowledge to enhance their leadership skills and become actively involved in making a difference in their community.

Who can be in Leadership Randolph County?

Leadership Randolph County participants must live or work in Randolph County, demonstrate leadership ability and possess a strong commitment to serve the community. The Leadership Randolph County program seeks diversity in the class makeup for representation of a broad cross-section of the community. The Leadership Randolph County Advisory Board reviews and selects the class participants based on employer nomination, the application and letters of recommendation. Each participant will be required to submit two letters of recommendation, one being from their employer. Spouses will not be allowed to participate in the same class.

What is the cost of Leadership Randolph County?

Each chosen participant will be required to provide a tuition payment of \$300 by August 5, 2016, which covers lodging and meals. Each participant will be responsible for their own transportation.

What are the goals of Leadership Randolph County?

- To seek out, train and promote high achievers for positions of voluntary responsibility in Randolph County
- To establish a communication network among the existing and emerging leaders of Randolph County
- To challenge these leaders to increase their involvement in community affairs
- To educate aspiring leaders and support their growth through leadership training and community
 education, so they may serve as catalysts in the Randolph County community.
