Prepare

Check your eligibility

You may be eligible for more than one benefit, based on your service. When you apply, you have to pick which one you want to use:

- Post- 9/11 GI Bill (Chapter 33)
- Montgomery GI Bill (MGIB-AD, Chapter 30)
- Montgomery GI Bill Selected Reserve (MGIB-SR, Chapter 1606)
- <u>Post-Vietnam Era Veterans' Educational Assistance Program</u> (VEAP, Chapter 32)

Other Ways to Apply

We usually process claims within 30 days.


