Ammunition provided: *9mm, .40 S&W, .45 ACP, 12 gauge (low impulse buck and slug)*
Personal or departmental semi-auto shotguns may need to bring high impulse buck and slug.

Meals and lodging NOT provided.

All portions of the course will be conducted at BRTC-LETA classrooms and range in Pocahontas.

Participants are required to have completed a CLEST-certified Instructor Development course.

Participants are required to submit the BRTC-LETA application prior to the start of the class.

Participants must pass the CLEST-recommended course-of-fire with a 90% (450/500) score on the B-27 target on Day 1. Students will have 2 chances to shoot a 90% score. Those who do not meet the 90% minimum score will be dismissed from the class. Course is available for download on www.clest.org.

Participants should bring the following items to the class:

Reliable duty weapon with a minimum of 3 magazines (4 mags for low capacity weapons)
-Weapon mounted light, if carried (holster must allow weapon to be holstered with light mounted).

Duty-style leather or nylon belt rig with a holster (has at least one level of retention) and a magazine pouch.

Cleaning/maintenance kit for the weapon.

Quality eye and ear protection (recommend clear eye pro and electronic-style earmuff ear pro, prescription eyewear is ok).

Body armor (soft armor or plate carrier).

Flashlight with batteries or fully charged / spare batteries for weapon mounted light, if being used.

Note-taking material.

Inclement weather gear / ball cap/ gloves you can shoot in.

Water.

Duty shotgun (Remington 870 available if needed).

Personal meds / med kit.
