You have been selected to verify your High School Completion Status. Below is a list of acceptable documentation. This information has to be turned in to the Financial Aid Office before your aid is processed.

High School Completion Status

Provide <u>one</u> of the following documents that indicate the student's high school completion status when the student will begin college:

- A copy of the student's high school diploma.
- A copy of the student's final official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.
- A copy of the student's General Educational Development (GED) certificate or GED transcript.
- An academic transcript that indicates the student successfully completed at least a twoyear program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.
- If student is Homeschooled, the student will need to contact The Education Alliance by calling 501-978-5503 and request a High School Transcript to be sent to BRTC. This is a free service.

If the student is unable to obtain the documentation listed above, he or she must contact the financial aid office.
