

## **RN/RT TO EMT PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

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This program is for Registered Nurses and Respiratory Technicians with at least two years of experience.

- Orientation: Students will attend orientation at 9:00 a.m. in HE116 on the first day of class (1<sup>st</sup> day of the month) to sign up for various services mandated by the state of Arkansas and BRTC, such as application to the Arkansas Department of Health, background check, FISDAP (testing website), and Moodle.
- Clinicals: Students must complete 48 clinical hours.
- Hands-On Skills: Students must learn and demonstrate proficiency in specific skills. This will be completed on-campus, in the EMS classroom/lab, after students have successfully satisfied the criteria as stated in the syllabus. This will be scheduled during the week; individual work schedules will be considered before scheduling the time.
- Testing: After all requirements have been met, students must score at least 65% in each of the six categories (Medical, Trauma, Ob/Gyn, Operations, Cardiology, and Airway) before being allowed to test for National Registry.
- Pace: Students have four weeks to complete the program.
- State Fees: Background check and application fees must be paid before class completion and are as follows. For an Arkansas resident with a minimum of five years of residency, the fee is \$42; for an Arkansas resident with less than five years or an out-of-state resident, the fee is \$66.
